

# 2009 Review List for Umpires

Flip coin for home team. Check bats against 2003, 04 & 09 & current lists of illegal bats in rules.

Game's time limit...no new inning begins *after 55 minutes* are up...be ready to play 15 minutes prior to your team's LISTED scheduled start time. Forfeit called if team not ready 5 minutes after DECLARED start time.

Designate 3 "Female" positions in batting order and 3 females must be in the field defensively at all times.

Extra Hitter is 11th batter in the lineup and is a starting position. Starters may reenter the game only once *as per ASA Rules* and MUST BAT IN ORIGINAL SPOT IN BATTING ORDER when reentered.

Report all substitutions to umpire or official scorekeeper.

Teams declare at the umpire's pregame conference their outfield defensive alignment (3-outfielders who must remain outside the cones at least 120 feet or twice the length of the basepath from home plate until the ball is hit, and a short fielder-who must remain inside the cones until the ball is hit or 4 across-all of whom remain outside the cones until the ball is hit) and must keep that alignment for all batters during the game.

Pitcher/catcher must be one male and one female. *As per ASA Rules, the pitcher must pitch from a stopped position ON THE RUBBER and MAY use a backhanded delivery.*

Balls and strikes are called from a zone of THE PLATE PLUS 4 INCHES ON THE OUTSIDE AND 2 INCHES ON THE INSIDE OF THE PLATE which crosses between the lowest knee or the highest shoulder when the batter takes a natural stance...in other words, a strike will be a hittable pitch.

A ball is called when the ball does not cross the strike zone, is more than 12 feet high, HITS ANY PART OF THE PLATE INCLUDING THE BLACK EDGE, or is lower than the pitcher's head.

If a male batter walks, the female batter after him may also walk only when 2 outs. *The male batter/base runner goes to second base in all cases* (whether or not the female bats).

➡ Count starts at ONE (1) ball, ONE (1) strike. A foul after 2 strikes is subject to the ASA courtesy foul rule. If extra innings are played, the count continues at 1 ball and 1 strike for all batters.

➡ The home run limit is three (3). Both teams must reach the limit before going one up at a time. Home runs other than the first 3 or one up per team after the limit will result in the batter being awarded first base.

The losing team must bat four times with a ten (10) run rule in effect (until final four round), unless twenty (20) runs is reached by one team...at which point the game ends immediately if a ten (10) run difference.

➡ Baserunners must avoid fielders who are fielding batted or thrown balls at all times. If the fielder blocks the base, a RUNNER MAY COLLIDE WITH OPEN PALMS OR BODY ONLY...NO HEAD, SHOULDER, OR FOREARMS. ➡ ➡ Male baserunners may not run into a female fielder unless he is sliding.

The WHITE PART of first base is for the fielder and is in fair territory. The colored part of first base is for the runner (except for rounding after a clear hit), and is in foul territory...regardless of the foul line.

COACHES MUST STAY IN COACHES' BOXES AND ONLY PLAYERS ON THE ROSTER MAY BE IN THE DUGOUT. Only the on deck batter may be on the field for the batting team. ALL OTHER PLAYERS AND EQUIPMENT ARE TO BE IN THE DUGOUT OR OFF OF THE FIELD OF PLAY.

No overthrow is automatic. AS LONG AS THE BALL IS WITHIN THE FENCE, THE BALL IS LIVE AND PLAYERS MAY ADVANCE AT THEIR OWN RISK.
